Please answer these questions in no more than one standard 8.5"x11" page:

1. What is your product or service?
 - a. Description of the product or service
 - b. How will your product or service be produced and/or distributed?
2. What is your market?
 - a. The market need which is filled by your business
 - b. Who is your customer?
3. How will you finance your operation?
 - a. Value of start-up financing required
 - b. How will you secure this financing?
4. How will your business operate?
 - a. Who is on your management team?

WAIVER for participation in the Progress2Capital Business Plan Competition

The Entry includes a business overview and could include a full business plan and oral presentation if my team is selected to advance to further rounds of the Competition. The Entry will contain the ideas, inventions, and concepts (collective "Ideas") of my team and myself. I acknowledge the possibility and effect of possible disclosure of the Entry and any Ideas contained therein and understand neither the Presenters nor the Judges are responsible for protecting any Ideas in our Entry.

I understand that if my team is selected for the finals, I am responsible for covering any travel and lodging expenses to compete in the finals at Regina, Saskatchewan, Canada.

I hereby release the individual judges of the Competition, as well as the Presenters, their officers, employees, and agents, from liability for any damages or injury arising from the Competition, including damages from a disclosure of Ideas, and I waive any and all claims against the judges related to this Competition.
